Travis AFB Resale Lots

Policies

The 60th Force Support Squadron is not responsible for damages or stolen vehicles. The use of the vehicle or RV/Boat resale lots is at the owner's risk. By signing the Travis AFB Arts & Crafts User Agreement Form & Resale Permit, customer acknowledges having read the information regarding the use of the Travis Resale Lots.

Privately Owned Vehicle/Motorcycle Lot

- Only the legal owner of the vehicle may register for the resale lot. License plates and proof of current registration and insurance are required.
- Resale lot customers are limited to no more than three vehicles for sale per year.
- The permit fee (no proration) is \$40.00 per month/31 calendar days. This fee is non-refundable.
- You will be assigned a numbered space on the lot. Numbers are painted on the pavement on the lot. You can find the number in the "assigned area" box on your receipt and also on the "for sale" permit.
- If your vehicle does not sell and you wish to renew your permit, you must return to the Auto Hobby Shop on or before the "due out" date on the receipt/permit.
- If returning to renew, you must first visit the Auto Hobby Shop counter, where your new permit will issued.
- The Resale Lot permit must be displayed at all times in/on the vehicle being sold.
- Sellers of motorcycles, motor scooters and mopeds will not allow untrained potential active duty buyers to test drive the vehicle. Potential active duty buyers must provide proof of training (e.g. Motorcycle Safety Foundation Card or station safety staff stipulating the individuals licensing state has been approved by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation) before test driving the vehicle.

Recreational Vehicle/Boat (RV) Lot

- Only the legal owner of the vehicle may register for the RV/Boat resale lot. License plates and proof of current registration and insurance are required.
- RV/Boat lot customers are limited to no more than three vehicles for sale per year.
- The permit fee (no proration) is \$60.00 per month/31 calendar days. This fee is non-refundable.
- If your RV/Boat does not sell and you wish to renew your permit, you must return to the Auto Hobby Shop on or before the "due out" date on the receipt/permit.
- If returning to renew, you must first visit the Auto Hobby Shop counter, where your new permit will issued.
- The RV/Boat lot is not numbered, and you may select the best location to display your vehicle.
- The Resale Lot permit must be displayed at all times in/on the vehicle being sold.
