How To Find A Provider....

The FCC Providers are located on the official waiting list resource, militarychildcare.com. Once you review and add your name to the waiting list of a selected provider, you are welcome to call our office for any additional child care support needed. FCC providers are entrepreneurs and their operation is a personal business. As such, each provider determines their own contract policies, and the installation may not regulate the fees they charge for their services. Each home listed is closely monitored to ensure compliance with all licensing standards.

Functions of the FCC Office

The Family Child Care office oversees the licensed homes on Travis AFB. They inspect the homes at least monthly to ensure health, safety, food program, and developmental needs comply with Air Force guidelines. They mentor the providers in their training and developmental needs of the children and home. The staff is available to assist parents in finding childcare.

Child Dev. Center & Youth Center

If you want to place your child on the CDC or YC waiting list, please log on to militarychildcare.com, create a household profile and request care for each center.

Subsidy Care:

The AF FCC Subsidy program is meant to help with the cost of childcare within FCC homes. For participating providers, their weekly payments are paid thru a combination of parent fees and a reimbursement from AF. Parent's fees are calculated using their Total Family Income and then set to one of 14 payment categories.

Extended Duty Care (EDC):

The EDC program assists parents who work extra duty outside of their normal 50 hour per week childcare arrangement. Once reservation and supervisor verification forms are received, a provider is located and childcare is provided free of charge to the parent.

Home Community Care (HCC):

The HCC program assists ANG/AFR during their Primary UTA weekends. Once a reservation form is received, a provider is located and childcare is provided free of charge to the parent. Care dependent on provider availability.

Deployment/Remote Care:

The Deployment Care programs offer 16 hours of free childcare per child prior to, monthly and upon returning from deployments in support of contingency operations or a remote assignment.

Military Spouse Appt Care

The MSAC program assists military spouses who have approved appointments to attend when their spouse must work. The program allows for 16 hrs per child per month. Once a reservation form and appointment verification is received, a provider is located and child care is provided free of charge. Care is dependent on provider availability.

24/7 Supplemental Care:

The SCC program assists parents who regularly work extended shifts (12hrs +) and parents who regularly work outside the normal operating hours of the CDC and SA programs.

Emergency Medical Care (EMC):

The EMC program assists families who are experiencing an emergency medical issue with an immediate family member and have no one at home to provide care for their child.

Wounded Warrior Care (WWC):

The WWC program assists families of wounded warriors who have short-term childcare needs for medical & military appointments.

Child Care Support for Fallen Warrior (CCSFW):

The CCSFW program assists families of fallen military members who need childcare for military appointments.

PCS Care

Families PCSing in or out of Travis, are eligible to receive 20 free hours of childcare per child in our FCC homes. Simply bring a copy of your PCS orders to the Military and Family Readiness Center to get your certificate. Contact the FCC office directly for other branches of military service.
